Ethanol Producers Workshop Planned December 12

The N.C. State Energy Office and the U.S. Department of Energy will sponsor the "Ethanol Workshop for Rural America" on Dec. 12 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the Sheraton Four Seasons / Joseph S. Koury Convention Center in Greensboro.
